- **f.** The students performed the individual & group dances for above mentioned styles of dancing.
- **g.** This grabs the attention of people in boundaries and radius of annamacharya educational trust.
- h. The traditional dance performed by 3 students initially ornates the event and it makes a great replica as ancient indian culture welcome.
- i. Nearly 100 students involved in the program in dancing with various dancing styles, dress codes, and rhythm's.

- **j.** This admires the status of college as students were given gross root level practice to serve the society with cheer and inspiration.
- **k.** The press encouraged the sedulous practice of twenty days in the final performance in open area.

4. EVIDENCE OF SUCCESS
