DEMO ON FLASH CHROMATOGRAPHY

Flash chromatography was purchased from Switzerland under AICTE (RPS) from Buchi Analyticals.

Specifications of the instrument:
Buchi Sepacore Flash System
Pump manage : C-615
Pump Module : C-605
Flow rate : 2.5 to 250ml/min.
Column : Plastic and glass.
Capacity : 1 kg.



It was installed in the Pharmaceutical department lab by Mr. Nagaraju. He explained the benefits over traditional chromatography. Flash is medium pressure chromatography, an alternative to slow and often inefficient gravity.

It differs from the conventional technique in 2 ways.

- 1.Slightly smaller silica gel particles (250-400 mesh)
- 2.Due to restricted flow of solvent caused by the small gel particles, pressurized gas (10-15Psi) used to drive the solvent through the column of stationary phase and the net result is a rapid "over in a flash and high resolution
